<sup>2)</sup>: Total AIB Fee for the German Domain is based on international imports and exports as of 01 January 2012. The AIB Domain Fee for Germany will be passed on to German EECS account holders according to their imported and exported volumes up to a maximum total cap for the German Domain of 45.000 €. The maximum fee per imported or exported certificate is limited to 0,005 €/MWh. The given 0,002 €/MWh are to be considered as advance payment. This assumes constant transaction volumes for the German EECS Domain in the year 2012. Final balancing will take place after the end of 2012.

<sup>3)</sup> This fee only applies to issuing of certificates which relate to a production period up to 31 December 2011. For issuing of certificates relating to a production period as of 01 January 2012 no AIB Issuing Fee is charged.

Invoicing for above mentioned positions by the German Issuing Body will take place on quarterly basis. All fees apply to Full Members of RECS Deutschland e.V., irrespective of large or small status. For information on fees applicable for Part Members (with limited rights to use the German EECS Registry) please contact the German Issuing Body.
