PROFILE

Dr. Martin Cames joined Öko-Institut's Energy and Climate Protection division in 1994 as research fellow and heads the Berlin branch of the division since 2008. After his apprenticeship and three years of work experience as metal worker he was awarded the master craftsman diploma. From 1987 to 1993 he studied Economics and Political Science at the Freie Universität Berlin, concluding with a Diploma in Economics. In 2006, he was visiting researcher at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT), Joint Program on the Science and Policy of Global Change, Cambridge, MA (USA). In 2009, he finished his PhD on Emissions Trading and Innovation in the German Electricity Industry.

Martin has experience of more than 20 years in research and policy consultancy and has coordinated or contributed to several national and international research projects in the area of energy and climate change. He has extensive experience on the design, implementation and evaluation of energy and climate policies, particularly market-based instruments such as emissions trading or baseline and credit schemes. Moreover, he is familiar with the analysis of complex systems and economic modelling. Since many years he is working on national and international climate policies with specific focus on new market-based mechanisms as well as on instruments to address greenhouse gas emissions of international maritime transport and aviation.

Since 2008, he is member of the German delegation for the climate change talks under the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) focussing on offset mechanisms (CDM, JI) and international aviation and maritime transport (bunker fuels). From 2012 to 2014 he was a member of the Executive Board of the Clean Development Mechanism under the UNFCCC. Martin speaks German, English and Spanish.
